UPDATE - MCWD's Response to COVID-19 (Coronavirus)

The Mammoth Community Water District will continue to provide uninterrupted water and wastewater services to our customers amid the COVID-19 pandemic

Mammoth Lakes, California – March 27, 2020 – The District is staying informed and have staff available to respond to the constantly changing environment created by the COVID-19.

To protect the health and safety of our staff and the community in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the District created a Risk Minimization and Outbreak Response Plan. Due to the COVID-19 activity in our community, the District now has a percentage of staff working remotely and has implemented staggered work schedules for essential Operations and Maintenance staff.

- **MCWD will continue to supply uninterrupted water and wastewater services to the community**
- **Water Quality:** The District's current treatment process meets state and federal water treatment regulations and is effective in preventing the COVID-19 virus from being transmitted through our municipal water supply.
