

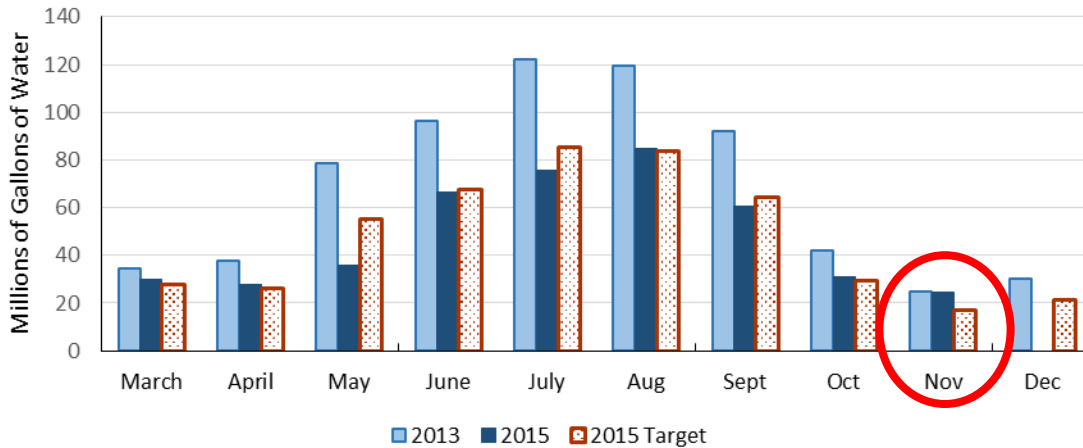

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For Immediate Release:
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Water Savings Decrease as Irrigation Season Ends in Mammoth Lakes

Mammoth Community Water District customers did an outstanding job saving water this summer. From May to October, 35% was saved when compared to 2013. The snow is falling, but the drought continues to affect our water supply. It will take time for our groundwater to recharge and a reliable snow pack to build. MCWD customers are still under Level 3 Water Shortage restrictions and we are still asking all customers to cut back water consumption by 30%.

In November 2015, MCWD supplied only 1% less water than in 2013. Please conserve water to help achieve our 30% reduction goal. Continue to save water by looking for ways to reduce indoors.

Water-Saving Tips

- Turn off the water while brushing your teeth - saves 3 gallons per day.
- Shorten your showers by 2 minutes - saves 5 gallons per shower.
- Wash full loads of laundry - saves 15 to 50 gallons per load.
- Use the garbage can rather than garbage disposal - saves 1 gallon per use
