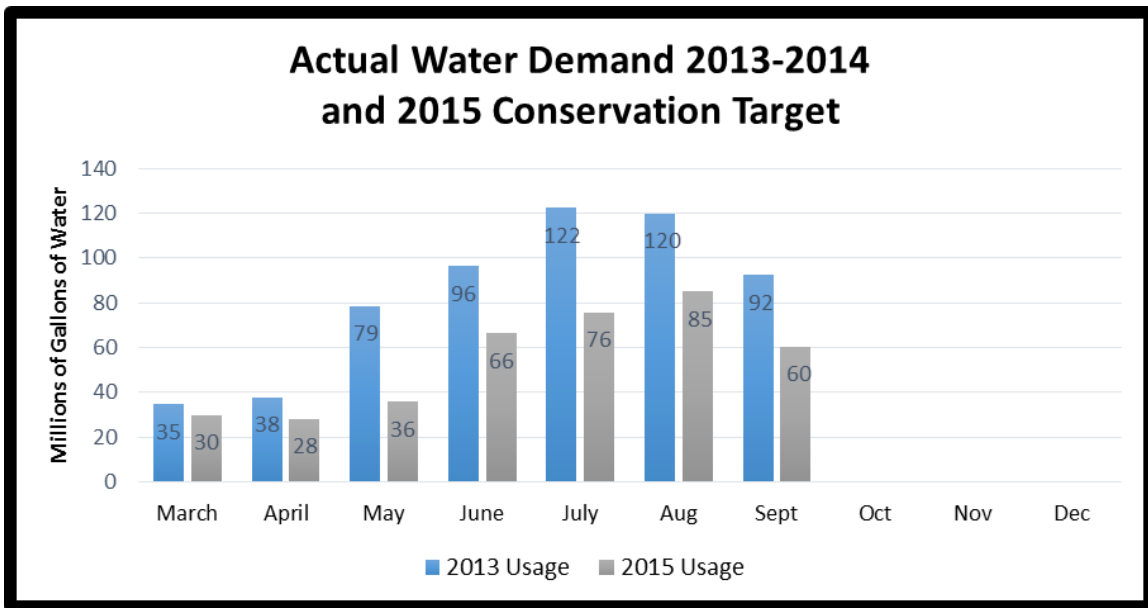

In July, the state recognized the Mammoth Community Water District as an “outstanding water saver.” Mammoth Community Water District (MCWD) customers have done an exceptional job conserving our community’s water resources this summer and August and September were no exception. When compared to 2013 usage (the baseline for comparison by the state and MCWD), MCWD customers used 66 million gallons less in August and September, exceeding our 30% reduction goal. Overall, since March, customers used about 200 million gallons less than in 2013. That amount of water could supply almost 2,500 households of four members for one year.



MCWD customers are still under Level 3 water restrictions. Groundwater aquifers remain low and surface water is unavailable for use. MCWD is still entirely dependent on the low groundwater supplies due to the persistent drought conditions; the District is saving the limited available surface supply for emergency uses.
