Mammoth Lakes, California – On October 12th MCWD staff spent part of the morning removing trash from the shores and general areas around Lake Mary. Roughly half of MCWD’s staff members representing all six departments were in attendance. Common items collected included miscellaneous pieces of plastic, shoes, socks, cans, bottles, broken glass of all sizes, cigarette butts, fishing line, and other fishing gear. Lake Mary is the surface water supply for Mammoth Lakes.
