Turf Replacement Rebate Program



Terms and Conditions

- 1. Applicants must be water customers of the Mammoth Community Water District. Applications must be signed by the property owner or HOA representative.
- 2. Rebates are processed in the order they are received and are limited by available funding.
- 3. Customers are eligible to receive one Turf Replacement Program Rebate per property per year, May 1 through October 15.
- 4. Eligible customers may not have current delinquencies on their water bill.
- 5. Pre- and post-inspections are required. Irrigation system must be turned on at both inspections.
- 6. Submission of an application and completion of a pre-conversion inspection does not constitute program acceptance. Written confirmation will be provided within 2 weeks of the District completing the pre-inspection.
- 7. Approved applicants must complete their project within 90 days from receiving written approval or before October 1st, whichever comes first.
- 8. The rebate amount is \$2.00 per square foot of qualifying conversion area. Rebates will be awarded up to \$4,000 for residential properties, \$4,000 for commercial properties and \$10,000 per multi-family property. Checks are issued only to the property owner or HOA. Please allow 30 days after passing the post-conversion inspection to receive the rebate check.
- 9. MCWD will not issue an IRS Form 1099, but customers should consider the rebate when completing taxes.
- 10. The District enforces only the conditions of the Turf Replacement Rebate Program. The applicant is responsible for complying with all laws, policies, codes, and covenants that may apply.

Pre-Conversion Eligibility

- 1. Areas to be converted must be irrigated/maintained turf. Turf must be established, not freshly laid sod.
- 2. A minimum of 400 square feet of turf must be converted unless the project will eliminate all turf on the property. Turf must be removed, not relocated.
- 3. Before removing any turf, an application must be received by the District and the applicant must participate in a pre-conversion inspection conducted by District Staff. Beginning the project without District staff approval will make the conversion ineligible.

Requirements For Converted Areas

- 1. Irrigation System: If an automated irrigation system is used, it must be micro irrigation. Micro irrigation is defined as equipment that operates at a maximum of 30 PSI and has a flow rate of 30 gallons per hour or less. Irrigation controllers must be programmed for water efficiency and able to accommodate MCWD's irrigation schedule. If only a portion of turf is converted, the sprinkler system must be properly modified to meet the criteria listed above for the converted area. Over spray or pooling into the converted area will make the conversion ineligible for rebate. If irrigation system is not used, the existing irrigation system must be removed from the converted area.
- 2. **Plan for Converted Area:** A plan for the converted area, including plant list, must be submitted with the application. If the project is more than 2,500 square feet, it must comply with the Town of Mammoth Lakes' Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance (WELO). Documentation must include the following:
 - a. A landscape area plan which identifies hydro-zones for the converted area.
 - b. A plant list which includes the number of each plant being utilized in the converted area and in which hydro-zone the plants will be located. No high water use or annual plants will be approved. Information on how to select appropriate plants for Mammoth Lakes can be found here: mcwd.dst.ca.us/turf-replacement-program
 - c. A basic irrigation plan.
