The Mammoth Community Water District understands the concerns surrounding water resources in light of the recent devastating Los Angeles County wildfires. We want to reassure the community that maintaining and improving our water and wastewater systems remains our highest priority. Our dedicated staff consistently monitor, inspect, and maintain the network of pipes, pumps, storage tanks, and water sources to ensure that current and future needs of our community are met.

Additionally, the District works closely with local agencies, including the Mammoth Lakes Fire Protection District, the Eastern Sierra Climate & Communities Resilience Project, and the Inyo National Forest, to plan and implement initiatives that strengthen the resilience of our water resources.

The District encourages customers to take proactive steps toward disaster resilience by taking a few simple precautions: ensure that the nearest fire hydrant is clear of snow and accessible to emergency personnel; maintain defensible space around structures; locate your home's water shut-off valve and keep it easily accessible; practice water conservation; and ensure your contact information is up to date with the District. By taking these actions, you will help prepare both yourself and our community in the event of a natural disaster.
